2012 Requirements for Scholarship Applicants

General High School Community Scholarship (\$1000)

The Applicant must be enrolled in a high school in the Greater Houston area and rank among the top 15% of their graduating class with a minimum 2.50 GPA on a 4.00 scale (or its equivalent). The applicant must have documented involvement in extracurricular and community service activities, demonstrate financial need to pursue a college education, and demonstrate leadership ability.

All applications must meet the following criteria:

- Applications must be postmarked by the due date (March 1, 2012).
- Applications must be typed.
- An application will be considered for review only if it is *fully* completed with a single photo of the applicant.
- Must submit 3 letters of recommendation: letters may come from a teacher or a community leader familiar with the applicant, (i.e. minister, school leader, or a an active member of Zeta Phi Beta)
- All finalists will asked to attend a structured interview on **March 24, 2012** and must be present to be considered.

Dr. Alma R. Williams Endowed Scholarship (\$500)

Application criteria/requirements are the same as listed above for the Community Scholarship, with the following exceptions:

- Applicant must be planning to study history or political science as an undergraduate major
- Applicant must have a minimum of a 3.00 (on a 4.00 scale) GPA (or its equivalent)

Milton Ingram Endowed Scholarship (\$500)

Application criteria/requirements are the same as listed above for the Community Scholarship, with the following exceptions:

- Applicant must be the first in their immediate family planning to attend college
- Applicant must have a minimum of a 3.00 (on a 4.00 scale) GPA (or its equivalent)
